

## 2018 – 2019 PATRICK S.G. BAIN HOTEL INDUSTRY PARTNERS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

#### **CRITERIA**

Please note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Bahamas Hotel & Tourism Association (BHTA) and The Bahamas Hotel Restaurants Employers' Association (BHREA) are offering jointly sponsored scholarships to encourage advanced studies in hospitality and culinary-related areas at the University of The Bahamas. This is in addition to the efforts already underway by the respective organizations.

These scholarships are being offered in the name of the respective organizations and in tribute to the late Union Leader **Patrick S. G. Bain**, in recognition of his commitment to education and building business-labour partnerships.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION**

A one-year scholarship not to exceed \$1,000 per student is being offered toward the tuition of a Bahamian student or employee enrolling in the University of The Bahamas. Culinary Arts and Tourism Studies. The scholarship can be applied towards tuition, books, fees and lab charges related to courses of study. This would not extend to, school store charges or any accommodation-related expenses. The scholarship may be renewable based upon the recipient's ability to meet established renewal criteria and proof of twenty (20) hours of volunteerism with The Bahamas Hotel & Tourism Association.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Selection will be based on a number of factors, although no single factor will be considered on its own in determining eligibility, except the College's entrance requirement. The following criteria will be used to determine eligibility and selection:

- 1. Academic Merit based on grades, test scores, honours, awards and recommendations, it is required that the student have least five (5) BGCSEs to include Math, English and a Science with a grade of C or above and possess a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for Hospitality students and 2.75 for Culinary students.
- 2. Industry Exposure consideration will be given to the applicant's successful work experience and/or internship experience in the industry as well as to those students who have participated in a secondary school level program relevant to the industry.
- **3.** *Personal Qualities* Determined by testimonies of character, any volunteer work and involvement in civic, professional, religious and social activities.
- **4.** *Field of Study* The applicant must have an expressed intent in pursuing a career in the Tourism & Hospitality Industry in areas such as: Culinary Arts, Food and Beverage, Hospitality Management, Horticulture sciences, Housekeeping, Laundry, Maintenance, Engineering, Marine and Environmental Sciences and other industry-related career areas.

#### **APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

#### All applicants must submit all of the following:

- 1. Copies of relevant examination certificates or scores (BGCSE, SAT (if taken), certificates of completion, etc.)
- 2. Official transcripts from current school (if high school graduate or UB if currently enrolled).
- 3. Copy of letter of acceptance from the University of The Bahamas.
- 4. Three original letters of recommendation: one from current work or school and one from a responsible person (not a relative) who knows you well.
- 5. A resume clearly outlining work, school, leadership, community, extracurricular experiences.
- 6. A brief statement of career plans and intention to remain in The Bahamas to pursue their career in the industry.
- 7. Verification of Bahamian citizenship (Passport or Voters Card).

#### **Selection Process**

- A Selection Committee comprised of representation from The Bahamas Hotel & Tourism Association (BHTA), The Bahamas Hotel Restaurant Employers' Association (BHREA), University of The Bahamas (UB), The Ministry of Tourism (MOT) or their designees and two individuals agreed to by BHTA.
- All applications should be submitted by April 30th of each year and selection made within 90 days.

#### **Eligible Costs**

- The scholarship can be applied towards tuition, books, fees and lab charges related to courses of study. This would not extend to, school store charges or any accommodation-related expenses.
- Funds will be sent directly to the University.

#### **Renewal Criteria**

The recipient must submit an official transcript to the Selection Committee after each semester within thirty
(30) days. For continuation of the scholarship, students must earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 for
Hospitality students and 2.75 for Culinary students or scholarship will be forfeited.

#### Statement of Intent

• The recipients of the scholarships will be expected to return/remain in The Bahamas to pursue a career in the hospitality/tourism industry.

#### Financial Contribution to the Program

The scholarship is supported by the industry with an annual contribution to the fund.
